Arrest of Abdulhakim Mujahid Muhammad

Sir,

On June 1, 2009 at approx. 1019 Hrs. Little Rock Police Officers responded to a shooting just occurred at 9112 N. Rodney Parham at the U.S. Army Recruiting Station. The officers stated that they had two victims that had been shot multiple times and requested Homicide Detectives and C.S.S.U.

Detective Simpson and I responded to the scene where we made contact with emergency personnel who were treating the victims. A crime scene had been established with crime scene tape. The first victim who was outside the business on the sidewalk was identified as William Long;(W/M6/26/85). The second victim who was on the floor inside the business was identified as Quinton Ezeagwula;(B/M,9/5/90). Both victims were transported to Baptist Hospital where Mr. Long died upon his arrival. Mr. Ezeagwula was rushed to surgery where he was listed in critical condition.

I assisted in marking evidence at the scene such as shell casings and interviewed witnesses inside the Recruiting Station. Detectives had received information that the suspect in this shooting was driving a black Ford Sport Trac. A short time later patrol officers stopped the suspect vehicle and the suspect was taken into custody.

The suspect was identified as Abdulhakim Mujahid Muhammad;(B/M7/9/85). The suspect's vehicle was secured and impounded by Patrol Officers and Violent Crime Detectives.


Detective Matt Nelson and I responded to the Downtown Detective Division where we made contact with Mr. Muhammad who was in Interview Room 4. Detective Nelson and I then took Mr. Muhammad to the Homicide Interview Room where I read his Miranda Rights to him. Mr. Muhammad agreed to waive his rights and gave a video and taped statement.

Mr. Muhammad stated that he was a practicing Muslim. Mr. Muhammad stated that he was mad at the U.S. Military because of what they had done to Muslims in the past. Mr. Muhammad stated that he took three weapons including an assault rifle and put them into his Ford Sport Trac. Mr. Muhammad further stated that he drove around in the vehicle and saw the Army Military Recruiting Station and two U.S. Soldiers smoking outside the building. Mr. Muhammad stated that he pulled onto the parking lot in front of the Recruiting Station, stopped his vehicle, and began shooting at the soldiers standing outside smoking. Mr. Muhammad stated that he fired several rounds at the soldiers with the intent of killing them. Mr. Muhammad further stated that he would have killed more soldiers if they had been on the parking lot.

Mr. Muhammad stated that he fled in his vehicle and drove down Markham and got onto Shackelford Road. Mr. Muhammad stated that he got onto I-630 heading east until he was stopped by Little Rock Police Officers and I-630 and I-30.

At the time of the shooting there were approx. fifteen Army and civilian personnel inside the Recruiting Station besides the two soldiers that were shot outside. Several of the rounds went into the Recruiting Station but did not strike anyone inside. Mr. Muhammad was charged with fifteen counts of a Terroristic Act for the individuals inside the Recruiting Station. One count of a Terroristic Act (Y Felony) for the shooting of Private Quinton Ezeagwula, and one count of Capitol Murder for the murder of Private William Long. Mr. Muhammad was then transported to the Pulaski County Jail for processing.

AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH & SEIZURE WARRANT

Comes Detective Robert A Martin of the Little Rock Police Department Detective Division, and on oath states that he has reasonable cause to believe that a black Ford Explorer Sport Trac located at 7801 Jamison, Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas (Little Rock Police Impound Crime Scene Bay) possesses evidence of a crime. In the vehicle being a black 2003 Ford Explorer Sport Trac bearing Tennessee License 585FFGK with vehicle identification number 1FMZU77E43UA24963 and being owned by Melvin Bledsoe, of 4800 Aspen, Memphis Tennessee 38128, there is certain property being concealed that is evidence of fruit of a crime or is contraband or is unlawfully possessed or otherwise subject to seizure.

FACTS CONSTITUTING REASONABLE CAUSE:

On 06-01-09 at approximately 1019 hrs officers responded to a shooting at the Army Recruiting Center located at 9112 N Rodney Parham, Suite 133. Witnesses advised that a black Ford Explorer Sport Trac pulled up in front of the Army Recruiting Center and stopped at which time a black male inside the vehicle began shooting, firing several rounds before driving off the parking lot and heading south bound on North Rodney Parham Road.

Upon officers arrival they located a white male (William Long DOB: 06-26-85) lying on the sidewalk in front of the Army Recruiting Center. Mr. Long had been shot several times. According to witnesses Mr. Long was standing outside in front of the Army Recruiting Center smoking a cigarette when the shooting occurred. Officer also located a black male (Quinton I Ezeagwula BM DOB: 09-05-90) inside the Army Recruiting Center, Mr. Ezeagwula had been shot several times. According to witnesses Mr. Ezeagwula had been shot several times while standing inside the Army Recruiting Center. Both Mr. Long and Mr. Ezeagwula were transported by MEMS to Baptist Hospital where Mr. Long died from his injuries. Mr. Ezeagwula admitted to the hospital and is listed in critical condition.

Witnesses at 9112 N Rodney Parham advised officers on the scene that the suspect vehicle involved in the shooting fled the parking lot and was last seen heading south on North Rodney Parham Road. Officers made a broadcast describing the suspect vehicle at which time patrol officers located the vehicle eastbound on I-630. Officers stopped the vehicle at the I-630 and I-30 interchange. The driver and sole occupant of the vehicle was then taken into custody and identified as Abdulhakim Muhammad. While taking Mr. Muhammad into custody officers observed several firearms including an assault rifle which was consistent with the shell casing recovered at the crime scene.

While in custody Mr. Muhammad was advised of his Miranda rights by Homicide detectives, Mr. Muhammad stated he understood his rights and signed the form. Mr. Muhammad was also advised of his waiver of right which he stated he understood and signed the form. Mr. Muhammad waived his rights and admitted to shooting the subjects at 9112 N Rodney Parham and advised that his intent was to kill as many people in the Army as he could. Mr. Muhammad also advised detectives that in his vehicle were three firearms, ammunition and Molotov cocktails.



Affiant is of the opinion that the homicide being investigated by Little Rock Police Dept, that is located in the residence at, 12201 Mara Lynn Rd. Apt. 4205 Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas. Due to the violence associated with the incident described in the above facts and the possibility of other individuals being involved, the affiant believes that there is a possibility that other persons may be in the described residence and that these individuals may attempt to arm themselves or attempt to destroy evidence of this crime. For the protection of the serving officers and the protection of the evidence, the affiant prays that a Search and Seizure Warrant be issued allowing a search of the residence without knocking and announcing.


